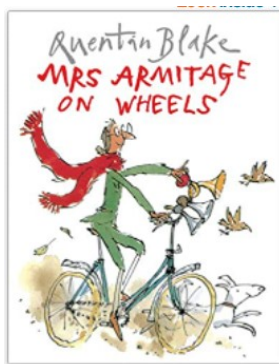




After half-term in Reception

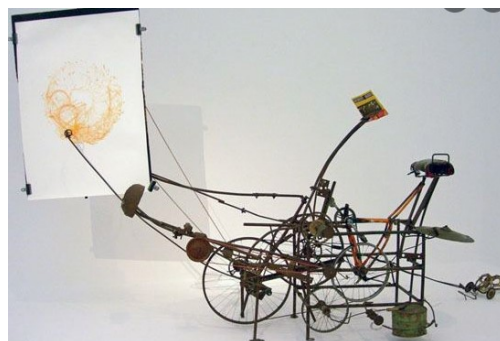
Maths

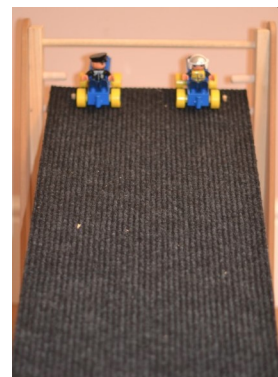
