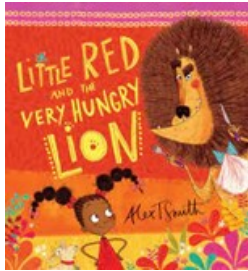




Next week in Year 1

Maths: Addition and Subtraction
