We also picked carrots from the Nursery and explored eating fresh carrots.

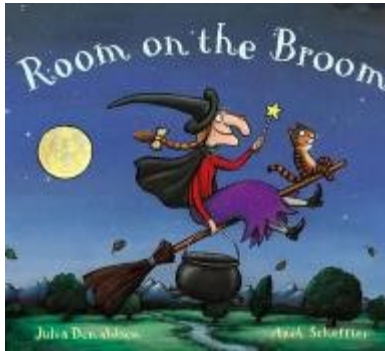




Next week in Nursery
