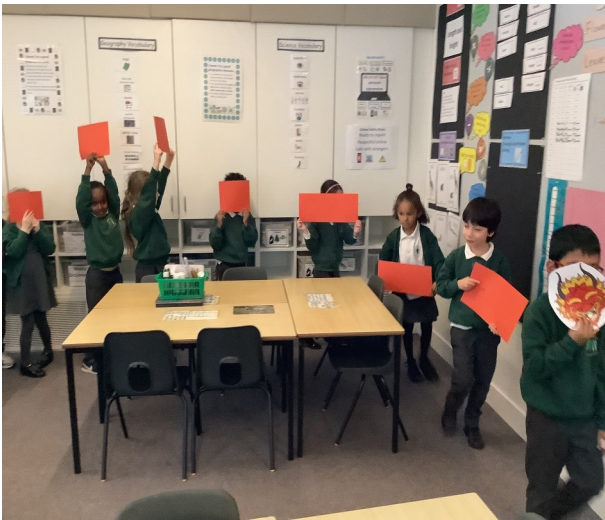

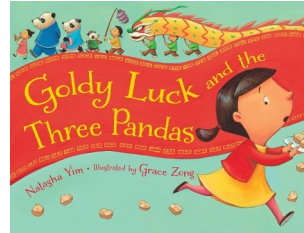
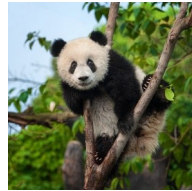


Next week in Year 1

We will also use containers filled with water and describe their capacity—full, half full, empty.



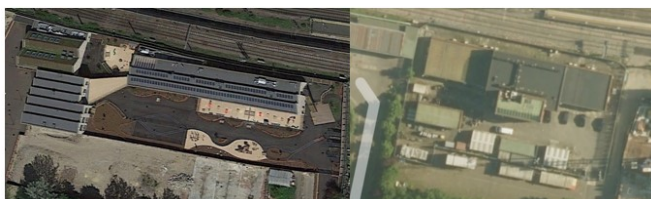
History: Transport Through Time
