power

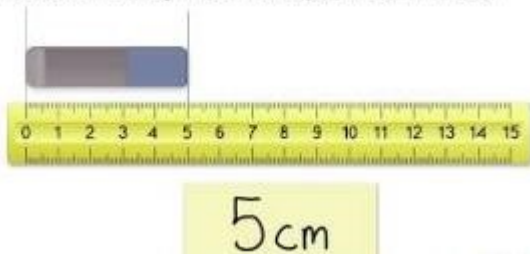
