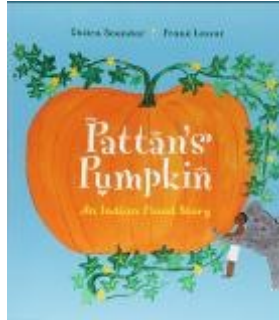


Next week in Year 1
