Click to read the green words.

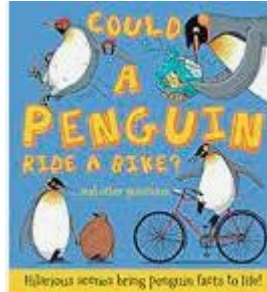




Next Week in Reception

Next week we will learn these words:

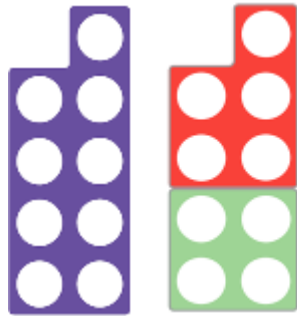

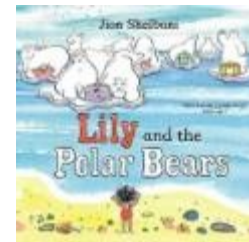
Maths
