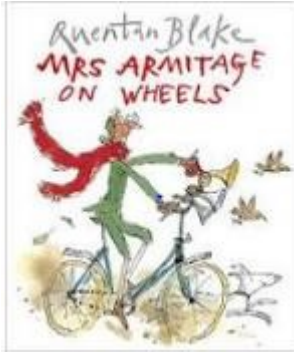




After half term in Reception

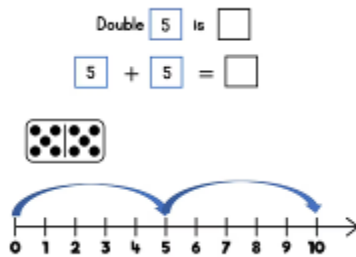

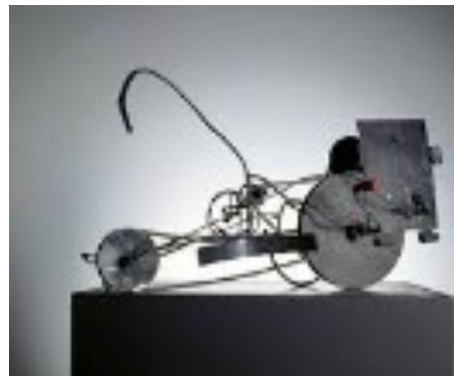
