Keeping your child safe online

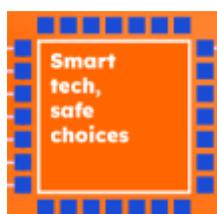
On the 10th of February, we will be supporting Safer Internet Day 2026. The theme this year is 'Smart Tech, Safe Choices'
