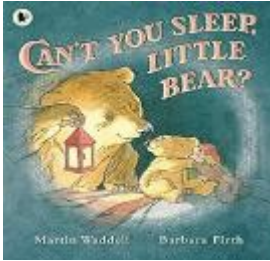




Next week in Nursery
