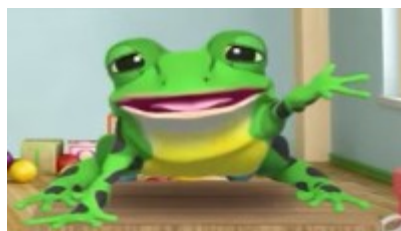


## Phonics

before

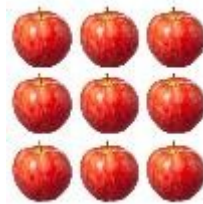
recipe destroy
